

Federal Civilian Employee Scholarship Program

Since 2019 First Command Educational Foundation (FCEF) is announcing has awarded three \$1,000 scholarships to Federal Civilian Employees or their dependents. In celebration of our 40th Anniversary in 2023, we will award four (4) \$1,000 scholarships!

The Federal Civilian Employee Scholarship is open to both to traditional and non-traditional students. If you meet the following criteria, complete the scholarship application and submit it, along with the other required documentation to scholarships@fcef.com. There is NO application fee. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applications are only accepted March 1 to April 15 annually.

Eligibility/Criteria

1. TRADITIONAL STUDENT:

- a. Must be a dependent* of a currently employed Federal Civilian Employee and a high school senior or current college student planning to attend or return to an undergraduate or graduate school, or accredited trade school. (*Dependent is defined as children up to age 26 who rely on their parents as a primary source of income.)
- b. Students must have at least a 3.5 grade-point average (or equivalent).
- c. Must demonstrate an active role in community and volunteer activities.
- d. Must include basic transcript from current school and at least two letters of recommendation with application.

2. NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENT:

- a. Currently employed Federal Civilian Employee* who is planning to attend or return to an undergraduate or graduate school, or accredited trade school to improve career advancement opportunities. (*Federal Civilian Employee is defined as a person working directly for the federal government. Active duty military members are not considered civilian employees.)
- b. Must provide at least two letters of recommendation from current or previous supervisor with application.
- c. Must demonstrate an active role in community and volunteer activities.
- d. Must include copy of current resume and/or transcript with application.
