First Command Educational Foundation was founded in 1983 as a private foundation to support First Command Financial Services (FCFS) mission to educate the military. In January 2006 FCEF terminated its private foundation status and was recognized by the IRS as a 501(c)(3) public charity. Since that time, FCEF has operated independently of FCFS and its subsidiaries and has its own independent Board of Directors.

FCEF realizes that financial knowledge is not only necessary but must be accessible and attainable for all those who wish to improve their financial wellbeing. Accordingly, we develop and provide financial presentations, workshops, and comprehensive curricula which promote financial wellness and stability.

Financial Education

FCEF can either furnish speaker to deliver the instruction, or train members of requesting unit/organizations to present the material.

Scholarships

Our scholarship programs broaden education opportunities for hard-working students across the country regardless of heritage or financial circumstances. Developed and granted in partnership with community organizations such as military units, local military spouses' groups, ROTC units, civic clubs, and others; our scholarships are available to students pursuing college and trade school degrees. FCEF is proud to award an average of \$130,000 annually in scholarships around the nation to active duty or veteran service members, civilian federal employees, and their families. We have successfully maintained this annual average since 1983.
